## Franklin's Oldest Restaurant!

Established in 1952, at 99 W Jefferson St, "Ann's Restaurant" was originally known as "Alta's Place". Open 24 hours a day, the workload was split into two 12 hour shifts shared by original owners Alta Leach and her brother Elton. Twenty cents would purchase a hamburger and a cup of coffee.

With business booming, Alta's relocated to its present location. Following the death of her brother, Alta and her sister, Ann Daugherty, became business partners in 1968. After Alta's retirement, Ann became the sole proprietor and changed the name to Ann's Restaurant.

On August 31, 1987, a fire completely destroyed the building, Ann's Restaurant was rebuilt and reopened December 14, 1987. On July 1<sup>st</sup> 1998, Ann's was leased by Tara Treatment Center, an alcohol and drug rehabilitation facility. All of the restaurant's revenues are used to support the programs of Tara. As a patron of Ann's, not only are you investing in a meal, but you are making a difference in the lives of others.
